To consider and act upon an authorization for appropriations in the total amount of \$900,000 to finance (1) \$785,000 for the Highway Safety 2020 Program for the repair and improvement of Town roads and drainage, for road reconstruction, milling and paving, and (2) \$115,000 for radio repeater communication facilities for fire and public safety purposes, as well as to authorize the issuance of bonds and/or bond anticipation notes up to a total amount of \$900,000 and costs of issuance for those purposes, and to authorize the Mayor and Treasurer to determine certain terms and particulars in connection therewith.
