The Mayor mentioned maybe scheduling a Saturday meeting to visualize things. L. Fitzgerald questioned if a mock-up of the area could be done to help determine what the area would look like. S. Lusas-Kolodziej said she would speak to a few people that are good at artwork and see if its something they would be interested in.

The Mayor mentioned that demo of the grange is tentative to start after Veterans Day.

The committee set the next meeting date for November 3, 2020. They will discuss a write up/report of the survey results to be presented to the Town Council.

L. Fitzgerald said he will reach out to the Board of Recreation to discuss our discussion about a covered pavilion with stage at Hotchkiss Field.
